



SKILLED NURSING Visitor Fact Sheet

To help create a successful, safe visit, please adhere to the visitation rules below.

- ✓ Visitation can only occur if the facility has not had an onset of COVID-19 among staff or residents for at least 14 days.
- ✓ Visits are limited to two (2) visitors per resident and no more than 10% of current facility census at any time. Visitors under the age of 18 must be accompanied by an adult.
- ✓ Please practice proper hand sanitizing and hygiene upon and during your visit.
- ✓ Visiting is by appointment only. Visiting hours are between 9am and 4pm.
- ✓ Visits will be in outdoor areas, weather permitting.
 - Under certain circumstances, as decided by administration, visitation may occur indoors, in specific non-resident areas
 - Visitation is strictly prohibited in resident rooms with exceptions for end of life or compassionate care circumstances, as determined by administration
- ✓ Visitors MUST present a verified negative COVID test result within the last week (7 days). End of life or compassionate care circumstances are exempt from presenting a verified negative COVID test, but are still subject to all other guidelines.
- ✓ Visitors must be screen for signs and symptoms of COVID 19 prior to visit and provide nursing home with: first and last name, address, phone number, date and time of visit, and email address if available.
- ✓ Visitor Expectations:
 - Social distancing of minimum of 6 feet is required for all visits. *There can be no physical contact.* No gifts or personal items can be exchanged at this visits.
 - Masks/ face coverings or other required PPE must be worn throughout the entire visit. Masks must cover the nose and mouth at all times.
 - Hand sanitizing and /or hygiene should be done upon arrival and upon end of the visit.
 - Visitors who fail to adhere to these expectation may be prohibited from visitation for the duration of the state declared public health emergency.
