



Infection Control for Resident Outings

1. The resident will be provided masks to wear on outing.
2. Education will be provided to resident and family for keeping social distancing wearing masks and use of hand hygiene.
3. The family will be encouraged to have a rapid test done prior to leaving with resident.
4. Upon return, the resident will be provided a new mask and hand hygiene.
5. The resident will be monitored for 14 days for signs and symptoms of COVID-19.
6. A resident that is gone for more than 8 hours will be quarantined for 14 days after outing and tested for COVID-19.
7. The family will be screened upon bringing the resident back to know if there were any exposure issues.
