



Infection Control for Resident Outings

1. The resident will be provided masks to wear on outing.
2. Education will be provided to resident and family for keeping social distancing wearing masks and use of hand hygiene.
3. The family will be have a covid-19 test completed prior to visit and/or prior to leaving with resident.
4. Upon return, the resident will be provided a new mask and hand hygiene.
5. The resident will be monitored for 14 days for signs and symptoms of COVID-19 if suspected to have been in close contact with a COVID-19 positive person or have left the facility for more than 24 hours.
6. A resident that is gone for more than 24 hours will be quarantined (if not up to date with vaccines) for 10 days after outing and tested for COVID-19.
7. The family will be screened upon bringing the resident back to know if there were any exposure issues.
